

Local Resolution – Public toilets

As requested by CFWI I explored the situation in Camborne regarding our local public loos and was dismayed to discover that the one toilet open to the public in the County Council Rosewarne car park was scheduled to close, initially next March but then brought forward to September 2015.

I contacted the local BID Camborne Manager for information and to offer WI support, I also wrote to our MP George Eustice on the lines of the sample letter from CFWI.

In July Camborne Council launched the Community Toilet Scheme whereby five businesses in the centre of town, namely two pubs and three cafes, offer toilet facilities to all during business hours. The businesses are recompensed by the council for this public use so users do not need to be customers. This is the sign displayed by the businesses involved in the scheme.



So far the BID group are working to also keep the Rosewarne toilets open throughout the winter, depending on costs.
