



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

This information will help you with the planning of your entry to your WI Walking Netball Regional Festival and provide further details on what to expect so you can look forward to the event.

How do I make sure that I/my group is eligible for this event?

It is open to anyone who is currently participating in a WI Walking Netball session.

How much will it cost? Can I buy more than one ticket?

It will cost £5 per person to take part. There isn't an early bird or team discount available. If you would like to buy more than one ticket or buy enough tickets for your whole team, you certainly can.

Can I attend more than one festival?

Absolutely. If you loved one so much and there is another one your team would like to play in, all the details will be on our website.

We're a little bit nervous, what if everyone else is really good and been involved in Walking Netball longer than us?

We have planned this in a way that we hope all Walking Netballers can have a fantastic experience that is just right for them, enable you to play in a way that you want to and most importantly, have fun! Please contact your Festival Event Manager for further information.

Do we need any fancy kit or equipment? We have not been involved in a competition or festival before.

No, definitely not. You will need to wear clothing suitable for sports activity and trainers but it doesn't need to be netball dresses or anything special. We will provide the netball bibs so in terms of identifying which team is which on court, the umpires will use bib colour. However, if you do have your own bibs, they by all means, bring them along.



Do we need to provide our own umpire, scorer, first aider or any other roles?

No.....we will have all of that covered. We would however ask that teams do bring a first aid kit with them for minor things like plasters etc. It might also be worth popping a couple of ice packs in, as this is often the most frequently used item in a netball first aid kit.

Do we have to enter as a whole team, there aren't quite enough of us to do this?

No, you can enter as either individuals and we'll then pop people into teams with others. Or if your whole group can make it then go for it and bring a team. Either way is fine, we'd just recommend that for a team you have minimum of 8 people, maximum of 12 people. During a full day you might want to have a bit of a breather, so at least having 1 more person enables this. It's also always great to have someone cheering you on from the sidelines.

We've never played outside of our Walking Netball session, does this matter?

100% not! This can be your first step into taking part in a fun festival with other Walking Netballers.
