

BAKER CUP COMPETITION 2021

The Baker Cup Competition gives WIs the opportunity to study a particular subject in depth and to submit a presentation based on their work. The competition takes place every two years and is organised by the Environment and Public Affairs sub-committee. It is open to all WIs in Cornwall.

This year's theme is '**The Way Forward - Rediscovering Footpaths**'. The study may be presented in essay or 'scrapbook' form. Presentations should include illustrations, tables, maps, etc., as appropriate to the topic, as well as acknowledgements, references and sources.

The length of the submission should be 4,000- 6,000 words, and the study must be the work of at least 4 WI members. This is a great opportunity to get outdoors and let your creative juices flow!

Judging will be anonymous, therefore the name of the WI and the names of the participants must be provided separately or on a removable page. The entries will be judged by an expert from outside Cornwall.

Winners will be announced at the Annual Council Meeting in October 2021, where the winning entries will be displayed.

The closing date for applications is Thursday 25 February 2021, and the closing date for submissions is Thursday 27 May 2021.
