Royal Cornwall Showground, Wadebridge 8th, 9th, and 10th June, 2017
is to be organised by the Floral Art and Gardening Sub-Committee.

“Home Sweet Home”

A staged exhibit reflecting the theme must include the following:-

1. A sampler, any medium. (20 marks)
2. Cottage loaf. (20 marks)
3. Floral Art - Arrangement in a teapot. (20 marks)
4. *Backdrop - a view from the window, any medium, including art, photography, craft, etc., to be judged in situ. (20 marks)

Points will be awarded as above plus 20 points each for interpretation and staging – a total of 120.
Judges comments will be on display.

*Please note - on this occasion you are asked to indicate what medium your backdrop will be in to assist with judging. A form for completion and return will be sent with confirmation of your entry and needs to be returned by 30th April, 2017.

Accessories may be used.

Judging will be in accordance with “On with the Show” 2015 edition. See November/December County News for more information on how to obtain a copy of this valuable publication for both judges and competitors.

There are also individual awards for the best item of craft and floral art in this year's competition.

RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1, The entry must be the work of at least **four** members (preferably more); only **two** members may stage the exhibit. Staging of entries will take place between 8 am and 12 noon on Wednesday 7th June 2017. No staging after 12 noon. The marquee becomes very congested during staging and it is for this reason that we are asking exhibitors with **odd numbers to stage between 8 am and 10 am and even numbers between 10 am and 12 noon.**

2. Access to the showground on the Wednesday is via the West Entrance only.

3. All items to be judged must be easily removable and you should ensure that all such items have numbered labels, which will be supplied, attached.

4. Only one entry per WI.

5. **No cubicles** are to be used. The size of the exhibit should not exceed 22" x 22" x 3' high (56 cm x 56 cm x 91.5 cm high)

6. CFWI cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to articles, although every care will be taken of items submitted. *Valuable items should **not** be included.*

7. Please remember:

- ***The site is sloping.***
- ***Items must be suitable to withstand the duration of the Show. Some food can be a real problem. Humidity in the marquee can be high.***
- ***All items must be 'fit for purpose'.***

8. All entries **must be** checked in with the Steward on 8th June 2016 and checked out at the end of the show.

9. CARS ARE NOT TO BE PARKED OUTSIDE THE MARQUEE.

Members are permitted to unload equipment only, and must remove their cars **before** setting up their exhibit. Parking is allowed in the field opposite the main entrance. It is advisable to allow plenty of time to stage your exhibit, as this often takes longer than anticipated. Vehicles entering the showground are often slow moving, causing delays especially during mid-morning.

10. NO ENTRIES TO BE REMOVED UNTIL approximately 6.15 pm on Saturday 10th June. You are welcome to wait in the closed refreshment area. After various essential tasks have been carried out, you will be invited to enter the main marquee to collect your entries.

11. The Marquee will be unattended from approximately 8 pm on the Saturday evening and no responsibility will be accepted by CFWI for any entry remaining after that time. It should be noted that the marquee is often dismantled very early on the Sunday morning. If you are planning to collect your entry after 8 p.m. on the Saturday evening, please advise the steward when booking your entry in.

Please read all the rules very carefully.
