What is the event and how can I or my WI get involved?

As part of the partnership between the NFWI and England Netball we are delighted to be able to offer members of the WI an exclusive and hopefully interesting day at the international test match between England and Uganda (England Roses v Uganda She-Cranes).

As part of this you will experience a full international match as well as an interesting talk from England Netball's Chief Executive Joanna Adams about the organisation and netball itself. Any WI members can get involved in this.

What happens at an international netball match?

There is lots that goes on! You will see the teams warm up, you'll see the pride across the arena as the national anthems are sung before the four quarters of 15 minutes of top flight netball. Join with the crowd to cheer on the Roses and enjoy the atmosphere of live sport. The Copperbox has a capacity of 5,000 fans, making it a brilliant event.

Can I come on my own or do I have to come with other members of my WI?

We would love to welcome any members of the WI, however you choose to join us. If you want to come as a group and sit together just mention this when booking your tickets.

Can I bring friends and family who might not be members of the WI?

You are more than welcome to bring friends and family with you; space is limited in the half time experience so WI members will be prioritised for this.

How do I get to the Copper Box Arena and is there anything else I can do nearby whilst I'm there?

The Copper Box Arena is on the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park, the site of the London 2012 Olympics. Public transport is the best and easiest way to get to and from the Park, either by train or underground. The nearest over ground station is Hackney Wick (5 minute walk), the nearest underground station is Stratford (15 minute walk). Stratford International station is just a 10 minute walk away and St Pancras International & Kings Cross stations are just seven minutes away by train to Stratford International. The M25 is only a 25 minutes drive away and there is plenty of parking at the nearby Westfield shopping centre.

With the Westfield shopping centre just around the corner you could combine the match with a spot of Christmas shopping! There are also various restaurants in Westfield and weather permitting, a wonder through the Olympic Park is also a great option for those who fancy something away from the shops!

What happens at half time for the WI talk?

This will be exclusive to WI members – you will be directed to a room within the arena where Joanna Adams will share England Netball's story and give you some insight into all things netball, from winning the gold medal at the Commonwealth Games through to empowering women through sport and all sorts in between. You'll be treated to a cuppa and piece of cake as part of this half time experience.
