Wills Community focus

We currently have **250 individual groups**, schools and businesses registered with Clean Cornwall

309 organised litter picks and beach cleans were supported by Clean Cornwall

7057 individuals volunteered their spare time, totaling more then **16,342 hours** across Cornwall

The volunteer time equates to **£127,000.00** (Based on the UK minimum wage)additional support to Council services, supporting our waste contractors, Town and Parish Councils and local Communities.
