We can all make changes to help in "Renewing Enchanted Cornwall" - buying local, growing our own, recycling and mending things, using less plastic, and treading lightly on the planet.

This competition will get us all thinking and working to Build Back Better!

Wis are invited to create a staged exhibit reflecting the theme, using both their skills and imagination, but must include the following:-

- 1. Three individual, identical, savoury tartlets, containing protein of choice. Please remember your entry has to last for four days in an often hot and humid marquee. (20 marks)
- 2. A floral arrangement using bee friendly locally grown flowers and foliage without the use of Oasis/floristry foam and plastic free. Accessories may be used. (20 marks)
- 3. A piece of prose not more than 300 words of five ideas on "Renewing Enchanted Cornwall". The prose to be mounted for display at the Show, (which can be decorated) but a non mounted, text only, copy to be submitted in advance for prior judging. (See over for more information) (20 marks)
- 4. A wall hanging using recycled materials any medium. This needs to be removable for judging, so not a backdrop please. (20 marks)
- 5 A decorated keepsake box made from recycled or salvaged material. Any medium. (20 marks)

All items must suit the theme. Points will be awarded as above plus 20 points staging and 20 for interpretation – a total of 140.

Wherever possible local, seasonal produce should be used.

Judges comments will be on display. Accessories may be used. No cubicles or sides be used,

Judging will be in accordance with "On with the Show" 2015 edition. A copy of this valuable publication for both judges and competitors can be downloaded free from https://mywi.thewi.org.uk.

There will be additional awards for best cookery, craft and floral art items.
