## CORNWALL FEDERATION OF WOMENS INSTITUTES RULES OF THE CFWI 200+ CLUB

- 1. The Competition will be known as 'The CFWI 200+ Club', (hereinafter called the Club) and is registered at the County Office, Chy Noweth an Conteth.
- 2. The Club was launched on 1 January 2010, in accordance with the rules laid down by the Gambling Commission. The Federation was advised by NFWI in late 2011 that individual WIs will no longer be able to hold shares.
- 3. Participation in this Club is open to all CFWI members and their families excluding the Federation Trustees and the office staff.
- 4. The club is formed for fund-raising purposes and all proceeds raised by the Club, after provision of prizes and expenses will be devoted to the objects of the WI.
- 5. Applications for participation in the Club must be made to the Federation Secretary. The subscription shall be £10 per share per annum, or part thereof, the year being 1 January to 31 December. One prize will be drawn in each month, excluding January and August, making 10 opportunities to win in any given year. The prize money will be a minimum of 1/20<sup>th</sup> (one twentieth) of the net money received in the year.
- 6. There shall be 200+ units or shares, which can be held singly or in multiples. Each share must be registered in an individual name.
- 7. A copy of the rules will be issued to each shareholder and WI Secretary and further copies may be obtained from the CFWI office or CFWI website.
- 8. The Board of Trustees will make the draw. All winning names and the prize amounts will be published in County News. Each monthly winner will be notified by telephone or email.
- 9. Fully paid-up members of the Club are entitled to take part in all the draws.
- 10. The decision of the Board of Trustees of the Federation is final in any matter requiring adjudication. The Board of Trustees has the power to amend or revoke the Rules, in which event notification will be given in County News and by letter to each WI.
- 11. The Promoter of the Club shall be the CFWI Federation Secretary.
