To be displayed on a table 2'6" x 2'6" (76 cm x 76 cm) and to consist of the following:

2 x Cookery items

- 1 small Christmas pudding (to serve 4, 400 g)
- A small savoury tart to include cheese 4.5 in / 11 cm
- A preserve – Gentlemans Relish (110 g)
- A craft item – A decorative Victorian style greeting card featuring violets

A drink (Non-alcoholic) Spiced punch

A floral arrangement - A Victorian Nosegay tied with a ribbon

Backdrop and side panels permitted if desired. 20 marks for each item and 20 marks for general effect and interpretation.

Classes for individual WI members: No specific theme

Cookery

- A mini Christmas cake (not to exceed 4.5 in/ 11 cm)

Handicraft

- An embroidered handkerchief
- A Christmas cracker

Floral Art

- A small Christmas wreath – maximum 8" diameter (20 cm)
- A dried flower arrangement in a teacup
